



Newfoundland 's Viking Trail Self Drive (7 days)

Thousands of years of history come alive as you explore the West Coast of Newfoundland & Labrador. Learn about ancient peoples-the Maritime Archaic and Dorset Indians at Port au Choix, the Vikings in L'Anse aux Meadows, and the Basque Whalers in Red Bay - as you meet the hospitable and friendly people of today. See the beauty of Gros Morne National Park - a UNESCO World Heritage Site and coastal fishing communities. Take a boat tour in St. Anthony (weather permitting) where you may see whales and, depending on the time of year, icebergs!

Itinerary

Tour can start on any date (June - early September), subject to hotel availability

DAY 1: Arrive Corner Brook

Check into your accommodations in Corner Brook where you will spend your first night in Newfoundland & Labrador.

Note: *If you are arriving late, you may wish to overnight in Deer Lake instead of Corner Brook and this may be requested on booking for no additional charge, subject to availability.*

DAY 2: Corner Brook to Port au Choix

Travel to the fishing community of **Port au Choix** which juts slightly out into the Gulf of St. Lawrence on Newfoundland's northwest coast; people have lived here for 5,500 years. **(Breakfast)**

DAY 3: Port au Choix to St. Anthony

Travel up the Viking Trail to **L'Anse aux Meadows National Historic Site**, the first cultural discovery in the world to receive recognition as a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. Learn of the Vikings who walked here over a thousand years ago. Afterwards, check into your hotel for a two-night stay. **(Breakfast)**

DAY 4: St. Anthony Touring

Enjoy a morning **whale watching boat tour** (weather permitting) in St. Anthony before spending your afternoon exploring this vibrant town. Visit the **Grenfell Properties** to learn about **Dr. Wilfred Grenfell**, a medical missionary who dedicated his life to improving health, education, and living conditions in Labrador and Newfoundland, establishing hospitals, schools, and orphanages. **(Breakfast)**

Note: June and early July are the best time to see Titanic-size icebergs.

DAY 5: St. Anthony to Cow Head

Depart St. Anthony this morning, as you travel back down the coast to **Cow Head** in **Gros Morne National Park** for a two-night stay. **(Breakfast)**

DAY 6: Gros Morne Touring

Discover why **Gros Morne National Park**, a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**, is truly one of the highlights of your trip with a **scenic boat tour** on **Bonne Bay**; be on the look-out for the **bald eagles** that frequent the deep waters of the fjord and you will also see the **Tablelands**. This mountain of flat-topped rock of a kind usually found only deep in the earth's mantle is an awe-inspiring sight and it prompted the UNESCO World Heritage designation of the area. Today will be an unforgettable experience; some say the scenery that **Gros Morne** offers is unequalled in **Eastern Canada**. **(Breakfast)**

Option: Clients may request **on booking** to take a scenic boat tour on **Western Brook Pond** in lieu of the scenic boat tour on **Bonne Bay**. While some may consider the boat tour on Western Brook Pond to be a superior outing, please note that there is a 45-minute walk (3 km/2 miles) from the parking lot to the dock and a 45-minute walk back. **This option must be requested on booking.**

DAY 7: Depart Deer Lake

Arrangements end upon check-out from your hotel. **(Breakfast)**

Please note that based on driving time/distance, we recommend booking your flight for 1:30 PM or later.

Option to add Labrador onto your itinerary - please ask your reservations agent!
