



## **Newfoundland West to East Self Drive (12 days)**

With a history of Vikings, UNESCO World Heritage sites, incredible sea-bird and whale watching opportunities and immense icebergs, a trip to Canada's Newfoundland & Labrador promises a truly unique and memorable experience.

This comprehensive tour begins in Newfoundland & Labrador and features the best of "the Far East of the Western World". Travel from the northern most tip of the island of Newfoundland to the most easterly point in North America through national parks - including Gros Morne, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Learn of ancient peoples - the Maritime Archaic, Vikings, and Basques - as you travel to coastal fishing communities to meet the friendly and hospitable people of today. Boat tours provide the opportunity to see whales, thousands of seabirds, and, depending on the time of the year, icebergs! Sample local food and drink to become an honorary "Newfoundlander"!

### **Itinerary**

**Tour can start on any date (June - early September), subject to hotel availability**

#### **DAY 1: Arrive Corner Brook**

Check into your accommodations in Corner Brook where you will spend your first night in Newfoundland & Labrador.

**Note:** *If you are arriving late, you may wish to overnight in Deer Lake instead of Corner Brook and this may be requested on booking for no additional charge, subject to availability.*

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**DAY 2: Corner Brook to Port au Choix**

Travel to the fishing community of **Port au Choix** which juts slightly out into the Gulf of St. Lawrence on Newfoundland's northwest coast; people have lived here for 5,500 years. **(Breakfast)**

**DAY 3: Port au Choix to St. Anthony**

Travel up the Viking Trail to **L'Anse aux Meadows National Historic Site**, the first cultural discovery in the world to receive recognition as a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. Learn of the Vikings who walked here over a thousand years ago. Afterwards, check into your hotel for a two-night stay. **(Breakfast)**

**DAY 4: St. Anthony Touring**

Enjoy a morning **whale watching boat tour** (weather permitting) in St. Anthony before spending your afternoon exploring this vibrant town. Visit the **Grenfell Properties** to learn about **Dr. Wilfred Grenfell**, a medical missionary who dedicated his life to improving health, education, and living conditions in Labrador and Newfoundland, establishing hospitals, schools, and orphanages. **(Breakfast)**

***Note:** June and early July are the best time to see Titanic-size icebergs.*

**DAY 5: St. Anthony to Cow Head**

Depart St. Anthony this morning, as you travel back down the coast to **Cow Head** in **Gros Morne National Park** for a two-night stay. **(Breakfast)**

**DAY 6: Gros Morne Touring**

Discover why **Gros Morne National Park**, a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**, is truly one of the highlights of your trip with a **scenic boat tour** on **Bonne Bay**; be on the look-out for the **bald eagles** that frequent the deep waters of the fjord and you will also see the **Tablelands**. This mountain of flat-topped rock of a kind usually found only deep in the earth's mantle is an awe-inspiring sight and it prompted the UNESCO World Heritage designation of the area. Today will be an unforgettable experience; some say the scenery that **Gros Morne** offers is unequaled in **Eastern Canada**. **(Breakfast)**

***Option:** Clients may request **on booking** to take a scenic boat tour on **Western Brook Pond** in lieu of the scenic boat tour on **Bonne Bay**. While some may consider the boat tour on Western Brook Pond to be a superior outing, please note that there is a 45-minute walk (3 km/2 miles) from the parking lot to the dock and a 45-minute walk back. **This option must be requested on booking.***

**DAY 7: Cow Head to Gander**

Have your camera ready as your time in **Gros Morne National Park** draws to a close. Travel through **Central Newfoundland** on to **Gander**, famous as the basis of the hit Broadway Musical, **Come From Away**. Visit the **North Atlantic Aviation Museum** which hosts a variety of artifacts and displays chronicling Gander's role in the development of transatlantic aviation. **(Breakfast)**

**DAY 8: Gander to Clarenville**

A scenic drive along the rocky coast of **Notre Dame Bay** leads to the beautiful outport of **Twillingate** where you will visit **Long Point Lighthouse** and the **Prime Berth Fishery & Heritage Centre**. Keep your camera close at hand for wildlife as you drive through **Terra Nova National Park** and on to **Clarenville**, your home for the next two nights. **(Breakfast)**

**DAY 9: Bonavista & Trinity Touring**

Today you will experience two quaint, historic towns. First, visit **Bonavista**, where John Cabot first

arrived in North America in 1497. Learn about the hard life of the light keepers at **Cape Bonavista Lighthouse Provincial Historic Site** before continuing on to charming **Trinity**. Stroll the lanes and explore the many **historic buildings** preserved from the 18th century. **(Breakfast)**

#### **DAY 10: Clarenville to St. John's**

Continue on to the intriguing old seaport of **St. John's**, your home for the next two nights. North America's oldest city and Newfoundland's capital boasts a stunning location in the granite cliffs and slopes of the **Avalon Peninsula**. **(Breakfast)**

#### **DAY 11: Local Touring**

This morning, visit **Bay Bulls** for one of the highlights of your trip, a **boat tour** in the **Witless Bay Ecological Reserve** to search for **puffins** and other seabirds. Next, visit the most easterly point in North America, **Cape Spear National Historic Site**. The afternoon is yours to explore St. John's at your leisure. **(Breakfast)**

#### **DAY 12: Depart St. John's**

Arrangements end upon check-out from your hotel.
